Background:

The attached resolution is for the application to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board for a Clean Water State Revolving Fund ("CWSRF") loan for the purpose of acquiring funds to pay for Phase Two of an automated meter reading (AMR) system. This project is to purchase the meters and to install them using BAMA personnel. It is anticipated to take approximately seven years to complete all phases of the project. This loan would provide funds for the purchase of meters to be installed during the next two years of the

project. The loan amount is anticipated not to exceed \$2,100,000.
