Tax and Ad Valorem Revenues and Financing

Background:

The City is responsible for a \$13,500,000 Tax Increment Financing (TIF) District that encompasses the square mile from Kenosha to Houston and Elm Place to 9th Street. This TIF will be paid off by a combination of new property taxes generated by the TIF and new sales taxes in the TIF area.

Downtown area sales taxes collected for July through September 2016 totaled \$91,998.92. Sales taxes collected July through September 2017 totaled \$100,121.89. Ad Valorem tax collected July through September 2017 totaled \$192,060.72 and for the same three months in 2016 totaled, \$183,037.66. Total debt service paid to date is \$3,176,450.35.
