On June 17, 2019, the City entered into a Professional Services Agreement with the law firm of McDonald, McCann, Metcalf & Carwile, LLP. Steve Metcalf, with McCann, Metcalf & Carwile served as the City's primary legal representative in the matter of City of Broken Arrow v. Contech.
