**Title:**

#### Background:

On August 6, 2019 the City Council formed a twelve person Advisory Committee to review, analyze and prepare recommendations for improvements to New Orleans Square, previously known as Elm and New Orleans Special Study Area. After meeting for a year this committee presented its final report and recommendation to the City Council on Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> 2020. With the conclusion of this report the committee has concluded its assignment and has been dissolved.

The rejuvenation process of New Orleans Square has started and is in progress, with the start of Tactical Urbanism projects, the Branding and Marketing effort with Brandera and other studies to commence soon.

To continue with this effort, the City Council recommended to form a new informal advisory committee of about five persons on October 6, 2020. Since that time it has been suggested to expand the committee to

include an appointment by the City Manager and an appointment from the Broken Arrow Chamber.
