**Approval of and authorization to execute a purchase of Central Insurance Policies for the Bass Pro umbrella policy, and Bass Pro general liability policy, effective July 1, 2022**

#### Background:

Central Insurance Companies currently provides umbrella coverage and general liability coverage for the City-owned building occupied by Bass Pro Shops. The general liability policy provides premises liability coverage with limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence. The general liability policy premiums through Central totals \$4,022.00. Additionally, there is a separate \$5,000,000 umbrella policy offered by Central, which premiums total \$2,414.00. The renewal premiums for these two policies totals \$6,436.00 for FY 2022-2023.

Staff recommends approval of these policies offered by Central Insurance.
