Discussion, consideration, and possible approval of and authorization for the Mayor to execute a Proclamation declaring the week of April 23rd -29th, 2017, as “Volunteers in Police Service Week” in the City of Broken Arrow, and recognition of the volunteers in Police Service and presentation of a symbolic “check” from the volunteers for their provided services

Background:

The week of April 23rd -29th, 2017, is National Volunteer Appreciation Week. The Broken Arrow Police Department would like to recognize the 255 volunteers that make up the “Volunteers in Police Service” for the assistance they provide to the Broken Arrow Police Department and the City of Broken Arrow. These volunteers include the Volunteers in Police Service, BAPD Reserve Officers, Victims of Crime, Community Emergency Response Team, BAPD Chaplains, BAPD Animal Control and the Emergency Management volunteers. These volunteers have donated for the year 2017, 23,843.25 hours to the Police Department and the City of Broken Arrow. This translates into a savings of \$512,629.87 to the City of Broken Arrow.
